## Instructions:

The first owner of the calf should apply for its registration. These instructions are intended as a helpful overview, they do not replace or supercede the Rules or Bylaws. Refer to the Rules and/or Bylaws if necessary.

Please submit the original (white) copy to the office for processing and retain the carbon copy (yellow) for your records.

### Section 1 - Dam and Sire information

Dam's tattoo and birth date are requested in order to confirm identity. There are duplicate registration numbers between the ALR herd book and the Australian herd book, so the tattoo and date of birth verification is necessary. If the dam is not a registered Lowline, indicate her breed using the codes below.

Likewise, the sire's name is requested in order to verify his identity. If the sire is not a registered Lowline, indicate his breed from the following codes:

### Section 2 - Calf's Information

Calf's tattoo should be applied before the application for registration is submitted. Only the calf's identification tattoo is requested, please do not report a Brucellosis vaccination tattoo.

Calf's name: The tattoo will be also be used as the name if you do not fill in a name for the animal.

Mating Type: Both 1 - Artificial insemination and 3 - Embryo Transfer require an A.I. certificate if you are not the sire owner. Please submit A.I. certificates along with the registration application when they are required. Also, a copy of the 'certificate of embryo recovery' should accompany E.T. registrations.

If you acquired the calf in the form of a bred cow or as a calf at side, a report titled 'Breeding Service Record', which contains this information, should have accompanied the registration certificate of the dam when she was transferred to you. Please attach this report to the registration application to speed up your processing.

Parent verification by DNA testing is required for Fullblood registrations. If you have already collected the DNA sample, **label it with the calf's tattoo**, send it to the office with the registration application and add the DNA testing fee to the self billing worksheet. If you do not yet have the calf's DNA sample, include the fee for DNA testing on the self billing worksheet and you will receive a DNA kit. Please indicate whether you will submit a blood spot sample or a hair sample. In the case of twins, a hair sample will be required due to admixture of the blood with the other twin while in the womb.
